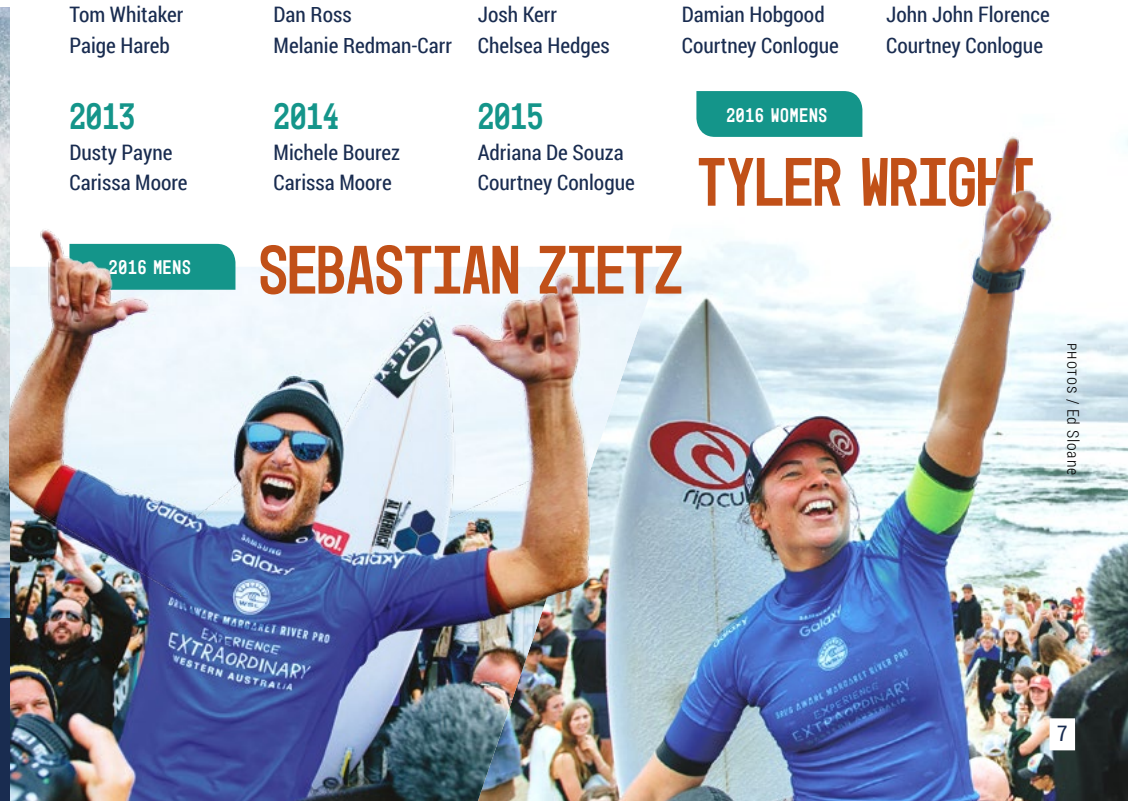

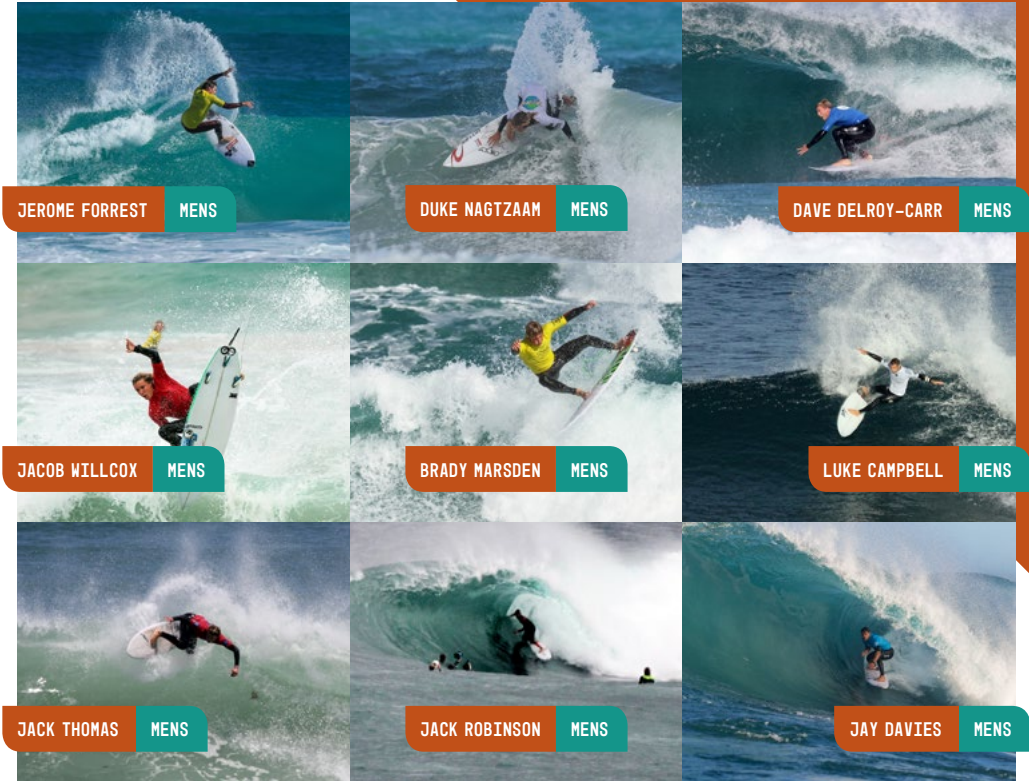
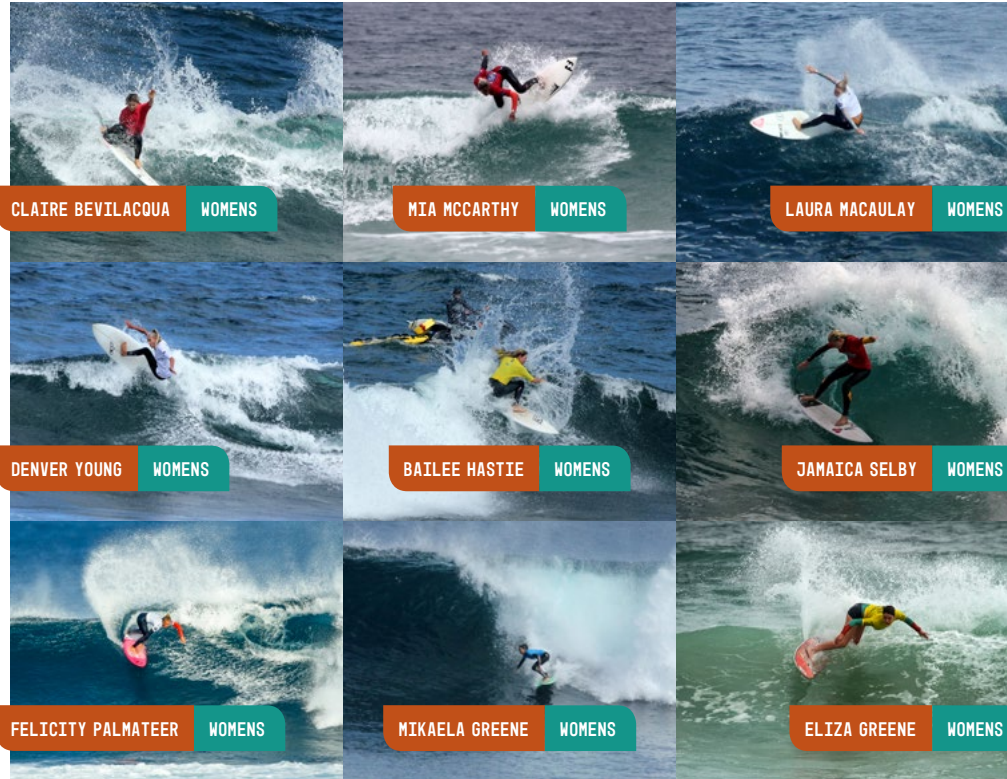

VEHICLE ACCESS

Residents and pass holders will need to display their coloured parking passes at all times in their front window screen to be able to move through traffic management checkpoints. Limited parking will be available in Prevelly, and event spectators are not permitted to park on private property. Free shuttle buses will be running throughout the competition, so park and ride.

SHUTTLE BUS

Free shuttle services will operate on all event days from Gnarabup Oval and Prevelly surrounds starting at 7:30am until last call.

Parking will be available on Walcliffe Road opposite the Golf Club, and free shuttle services will operate between 7:30am until last call on the 1st, 2nd, 8th and 9th of April.

Shuttles will be doing constant loops from pick up points to Surfers Point until event finish time. Please be aware that shuttle service will only be available on days when the event is running.

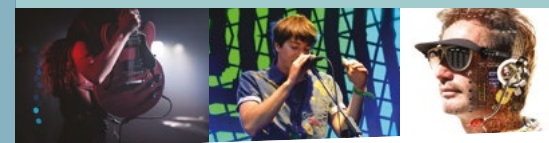

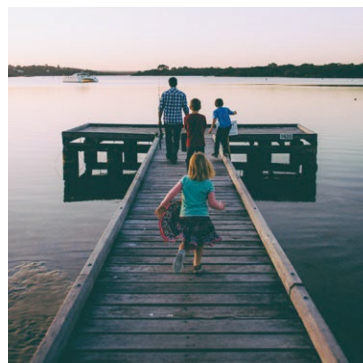

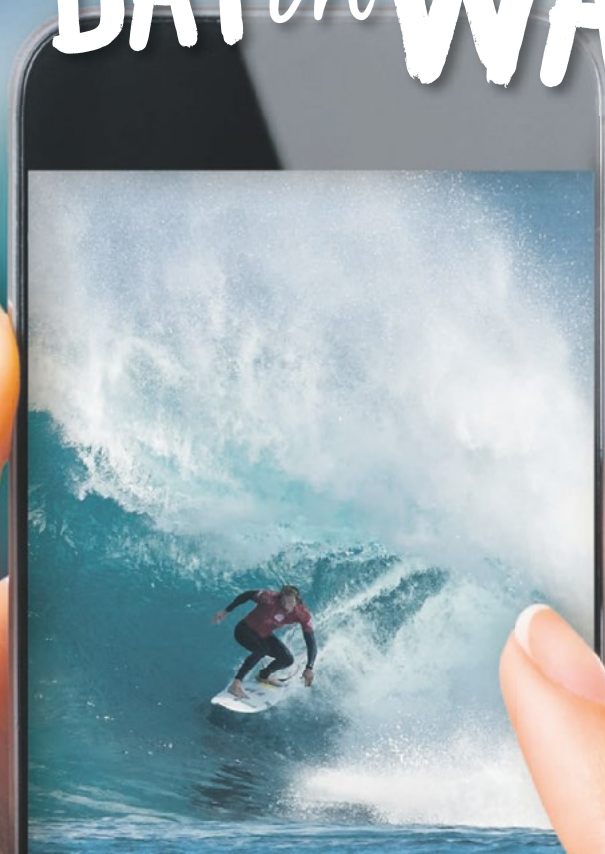
