



2018 Boardrider Club Insurance & Surfing NSW Affiliation

This year the cost of insurance has once again remained the same (since 2010) at **\$385.00**. Some of the benefits offered with this include:

- Public Liability Insurance – up to \$20 million public liability & \$5 million professional indemnity
- No additional insurance required for interclub events (with Surfing NSW clubs)
- Reduced fees for additional insurance for other events that your club runs/ hosts
- E-News and Updates of upcoming events, info
- Discount Surfing NSW membership for your members when you join as a club - group payment for 30 or more of your members, we will provide SNSW membership for \$33 per person (instead of \$55 per person).
- Australian Boardriders Battle – eligibility for you club to enter
- Boardrider Club listing on Surfing Australia website – access for your club to edit this information.
- Online membership – if you would like to take the hassle out of your membership sign up, you can register to do this through the Surfing NSW online payment system.

To renew your policy please complete the following documents.

1. Application form - Please ensure you include all the interested parties (councils, national parks, trusts etc.) accurately for your Certificate of Currency (CoC) – an admin fee will be charged if any alterations need to be made to your CoC.
2. Payment - \$385.00 - this can be done via – Cheque, credit card, EFT or online
3. Certificate of Incorporation
4. Risk management plan
5. Council Approval Notice
6. Club Member List (this is required by insurer they need to know who is registered with your club)

Please note: that we do understand you need insurance for council approval. Please forward council request with your application & then follow up with approval when received.

If your club is intending to hold events in January, you will need to have all paperwork & payments to Surfing NSW by 15th December to be able to receive your CoC's before the Surfing NSW/ Australia office closing dates.
